GEK TERNA: Free Diagnostic Tests for Covid-19 for the Group's Employees

The special action plan for safe return to work is in full progress

From the first moment of the pandemic GEK TERNA Group implemented its integrated Business Continuity Plan, which had already been prepared with the aim of ensuring Group's smooth operation in cases of crisis, placing as top priority the health and safety of its employees and partners around the world.

Monitoring closely the developments on the front of the pandemic and taking into account the rising numbers of infections and the instructions granted by the State, GEK TERNA Group acted accordingly and now provides free diagnostic molecular detection tests of the virus to its entire personnel. The goal is the safe return of all employees to their jobs after the end of the summer holidays, but also the protection of public health at this critical point in time.

The Business Continuity Plan of GEK TERNA Group includes strict operating rules applied to all Group's locations in Greece and abroad, while its implementation is monitored daily by a special working group set up to deal with the pandemic and in which the Group's executives as well as specialized scientific collaborators participate. The Plan envisages, inter alia, a program of remote or rotational work, particular care for all employee belonging to vulnerable groups, drastic restriction of travels to the necessary, as well as of meetings and / or events where the physical presence can be facilitated by making use of all possibilities that technology offers.

It is worth noting that from the first phase of the health crisis, in addition to the measures recommended by the Authorities and which were followed strictly and with absolute success in all Group's facilities around the world, the Group also ensured the safe repatriation of hundreds of its executives and employees who had been dealing with various projects implemented outside Greece, even with special charter flights, wherever required.

In addition, GEK TERNA Group implements a large support program to the Greek National Health System with donations of equipment and consumables to reference hospitals, both in the capital and across the country, as well as in health centers located in areas where it operates. Indicatively, to date, eight ICU beds of Attikon Hospital have been fully equipped, whereas uniforms and other essential supplies have been purchased for Evangelismos Hospital.

Also the Group has purchased first examination or hospital accommodation kiosks, as well as equipment and consumables for the reference hospitals of the region and for health centers in Attica, Crete, Ptolemaida, Serres, Ioannina, Evia, etc. The donation program continues as the needs remain great and public health protection has become a top priority.
